Major Projects (Part 3)

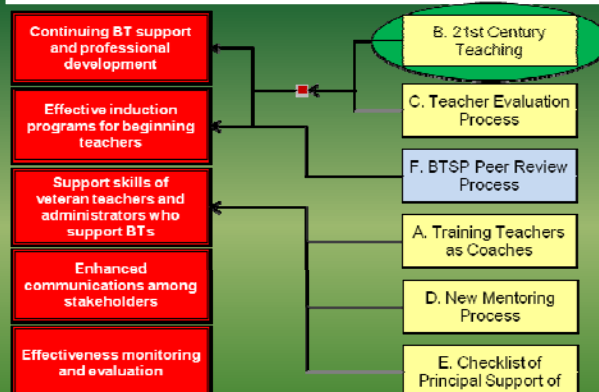
- Collaborative web sites to serve as tools for channeling resources to new teachers and those who support them
