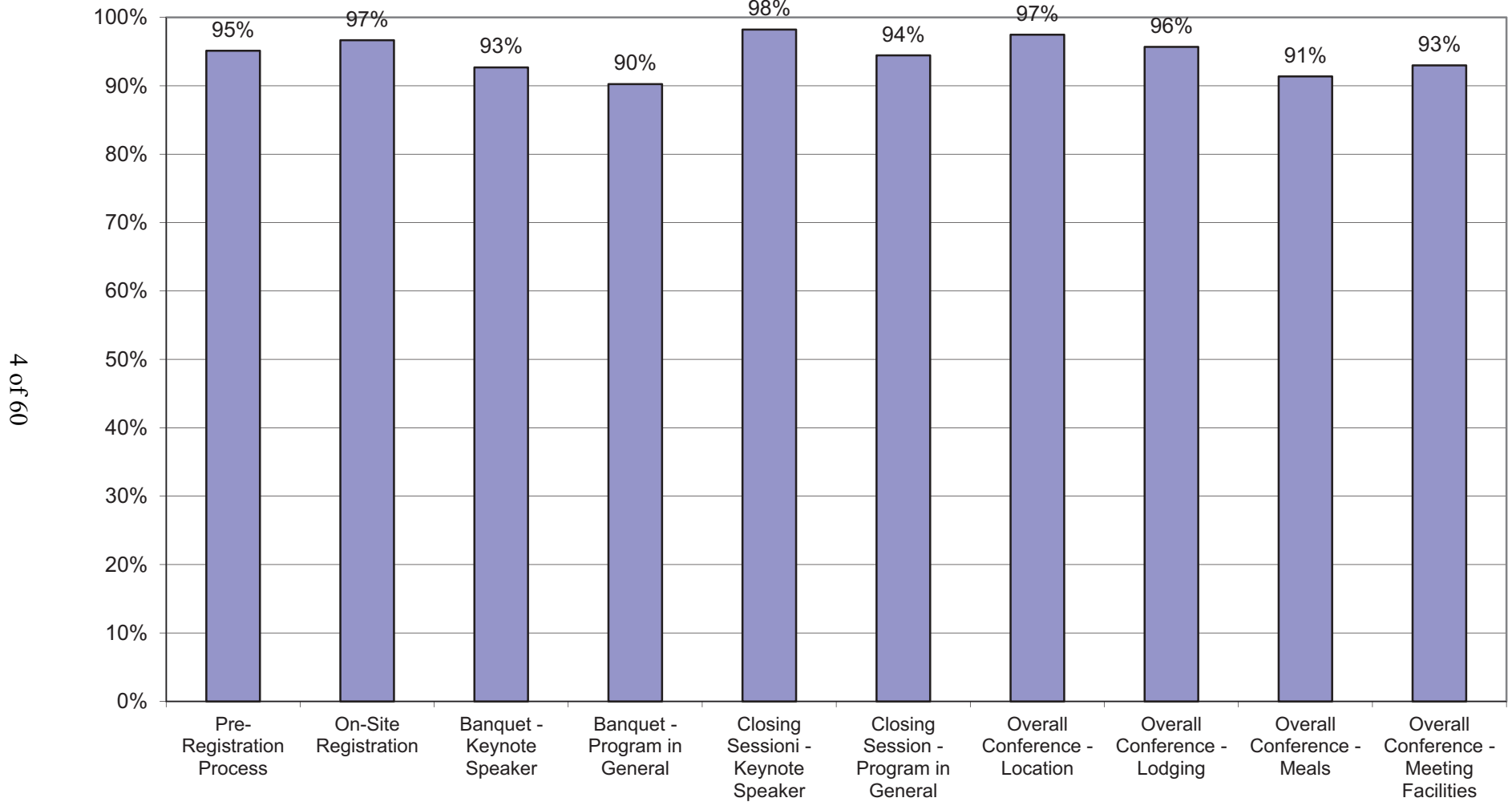

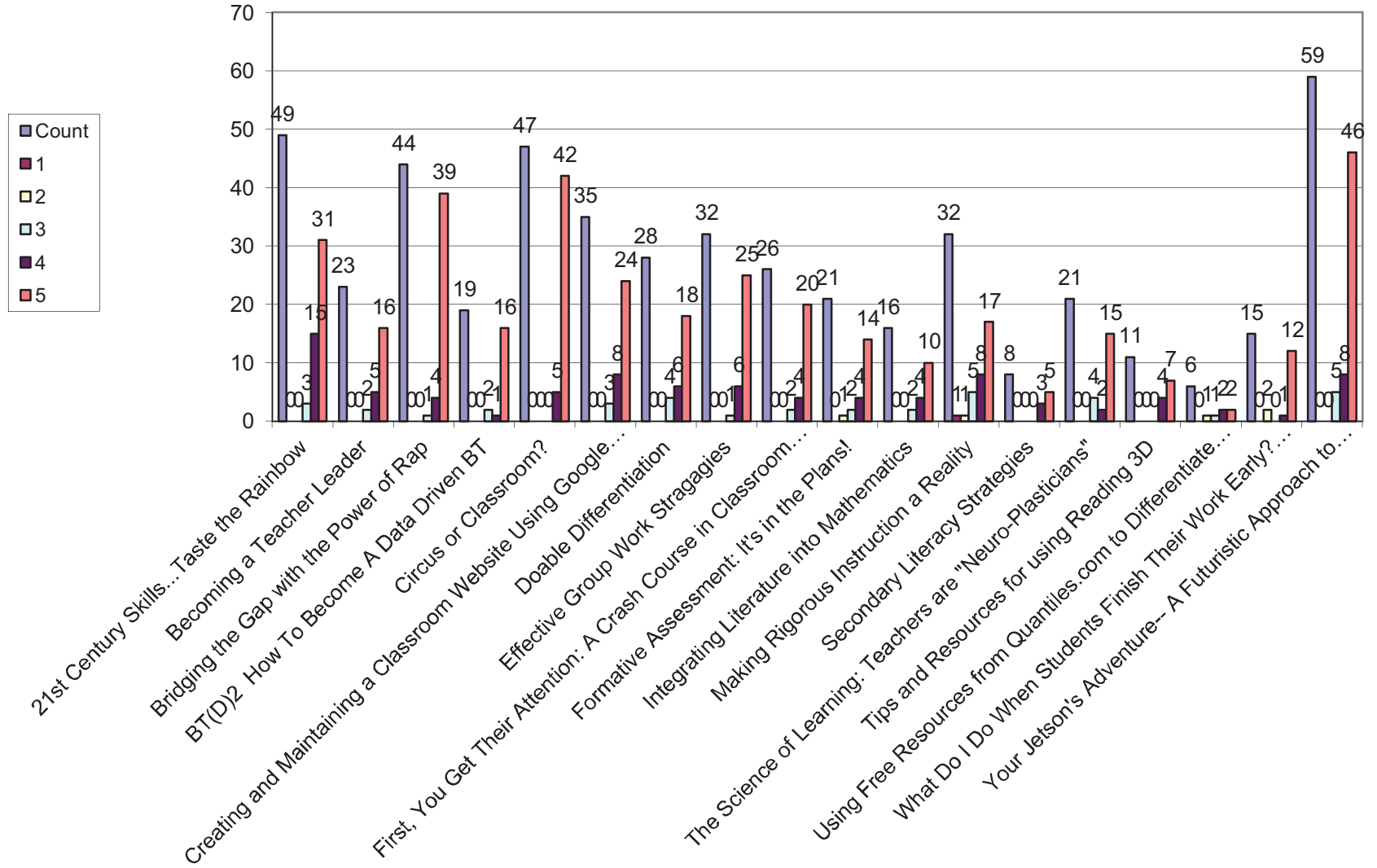

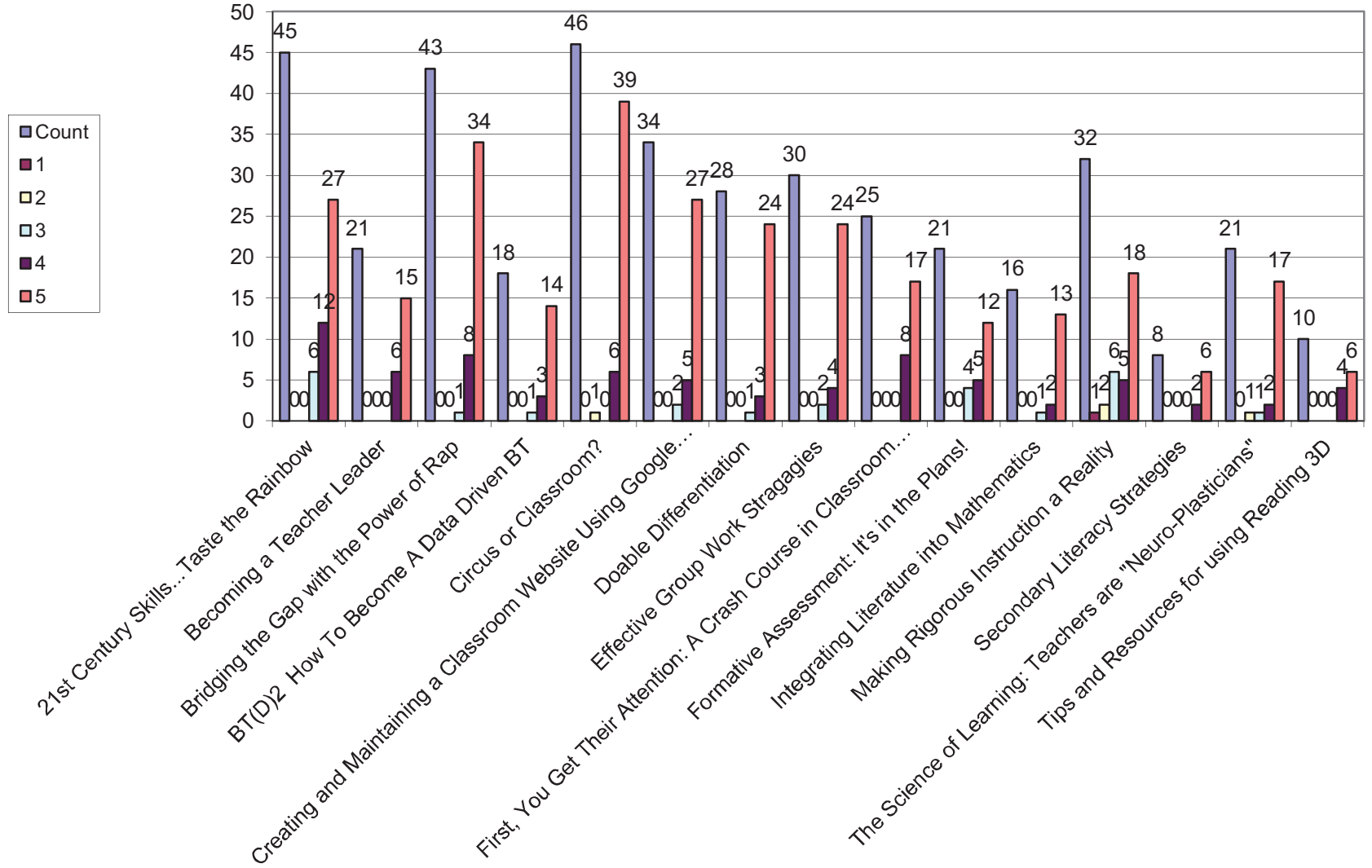

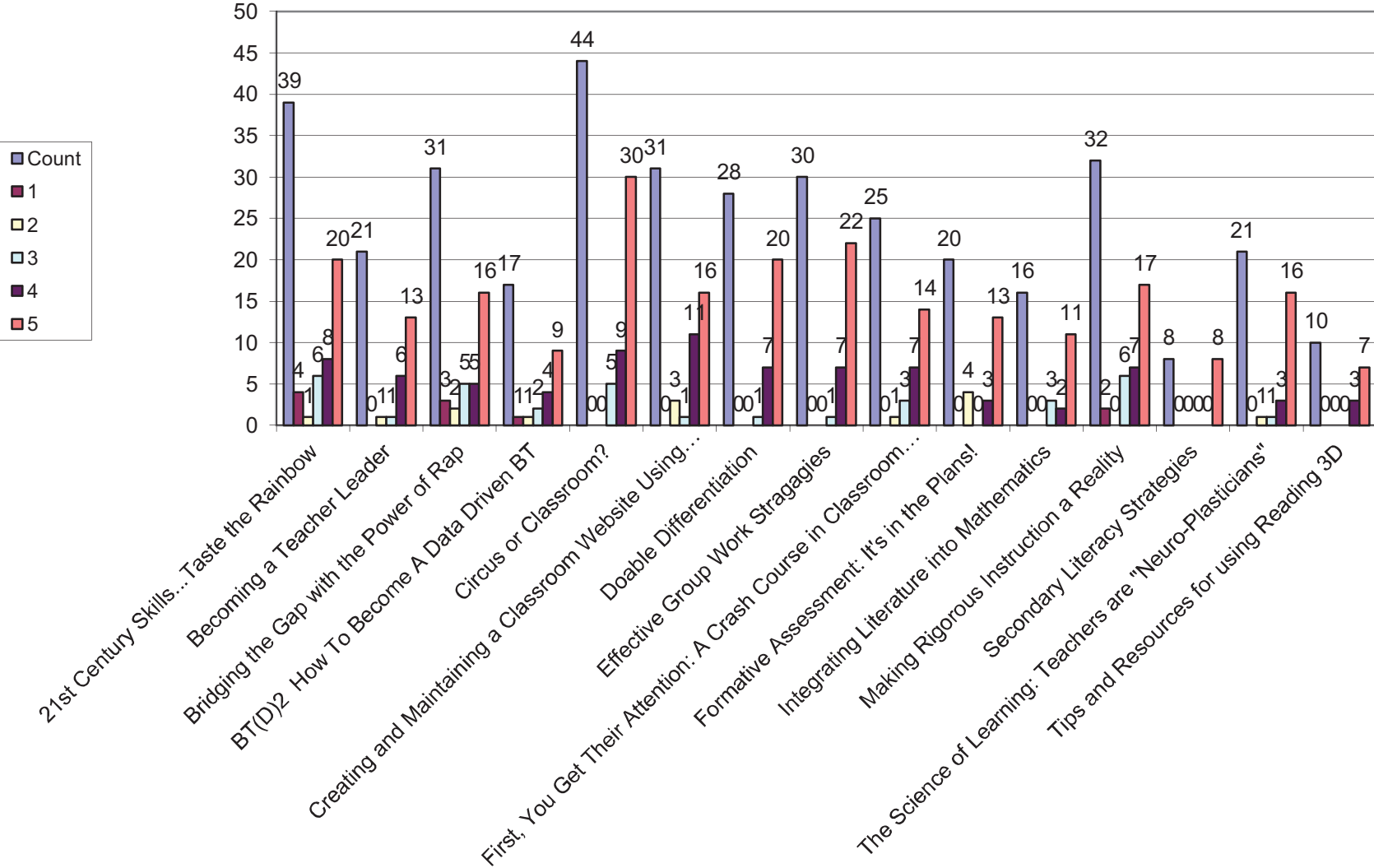
Concurrent Sessions Evaluation Summary - Presenters - 2013



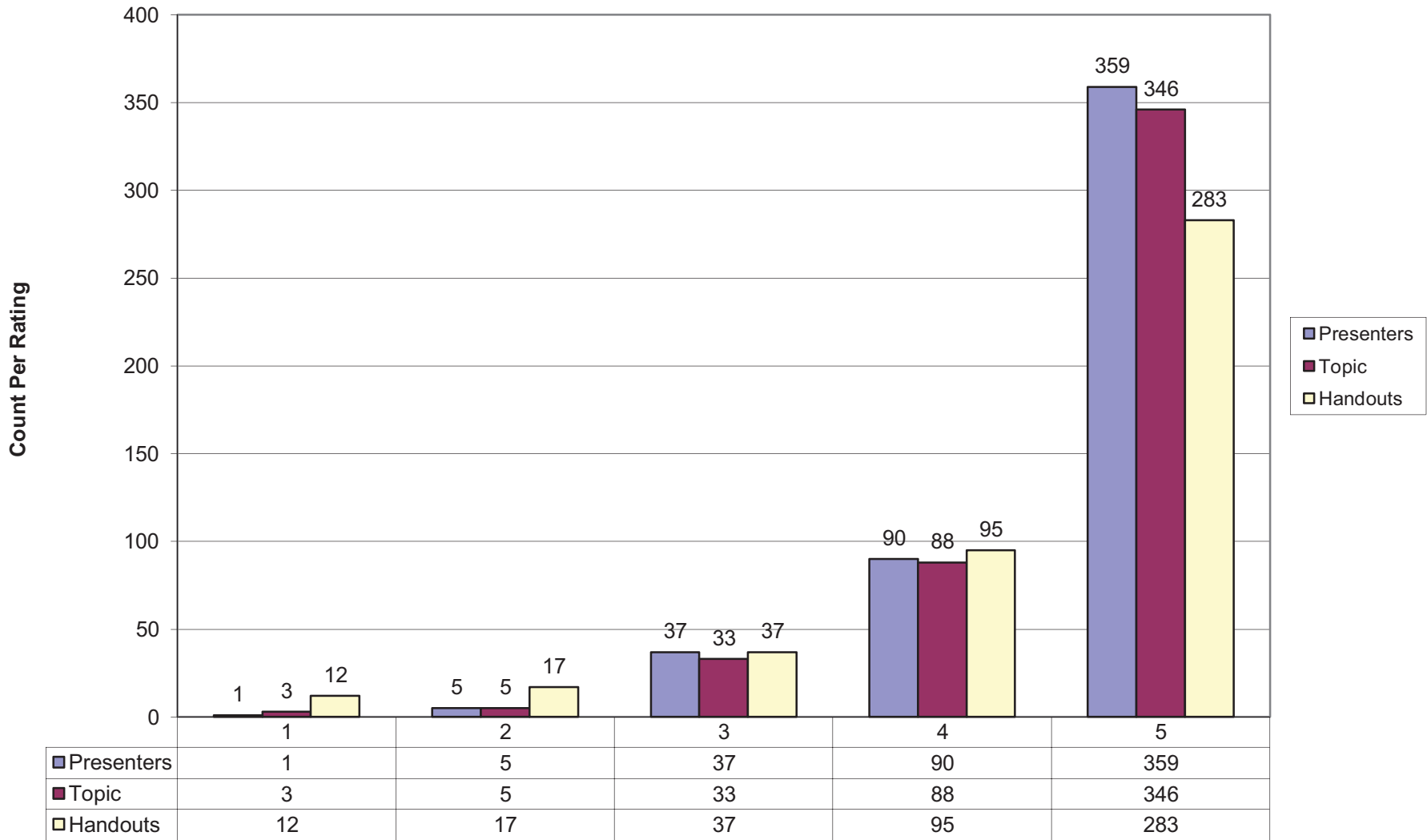
Concurrent Sessions Evaluation Summary - Topics - 2013



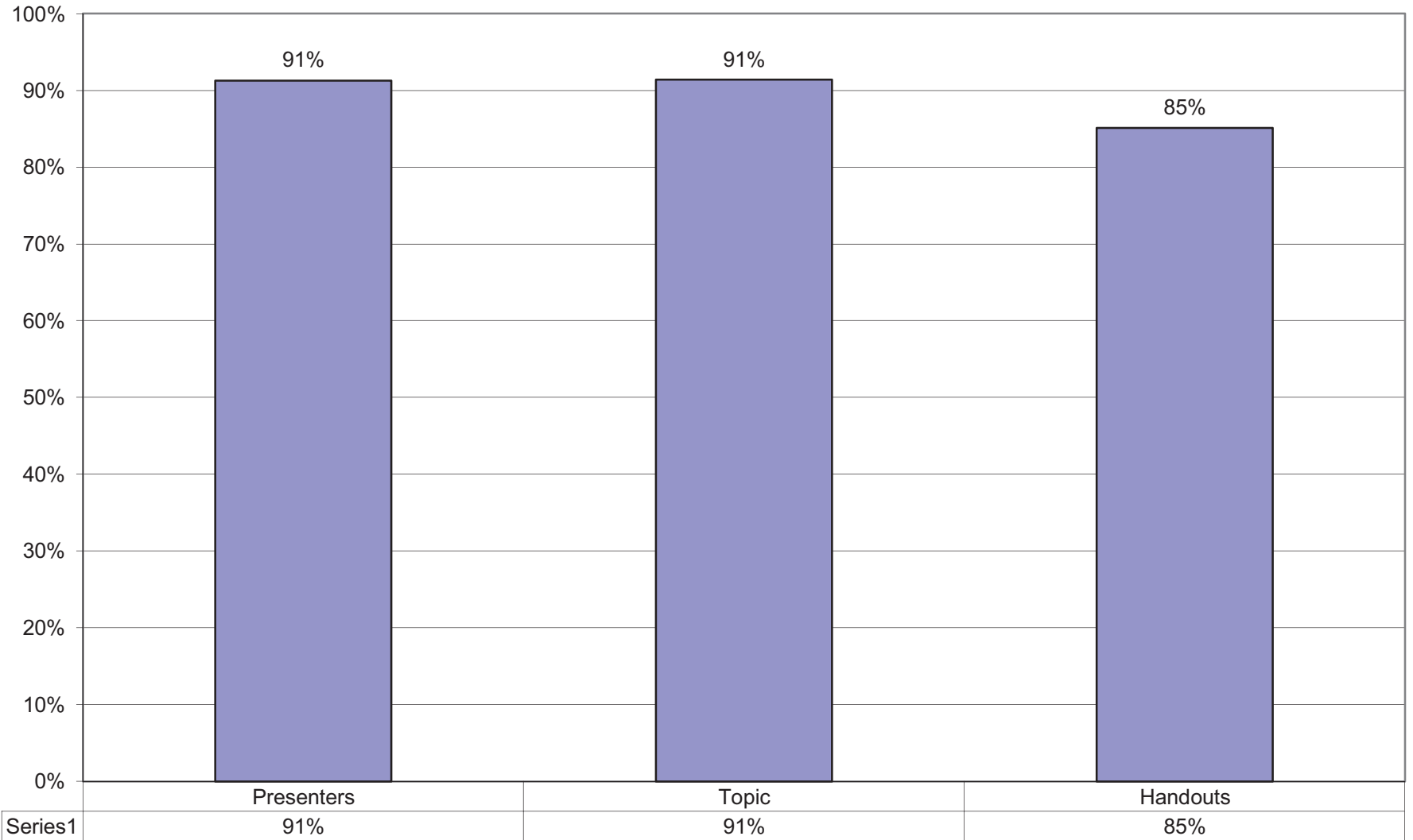
Concurrent Sessions Evaluation Summary - Handouts - 2013



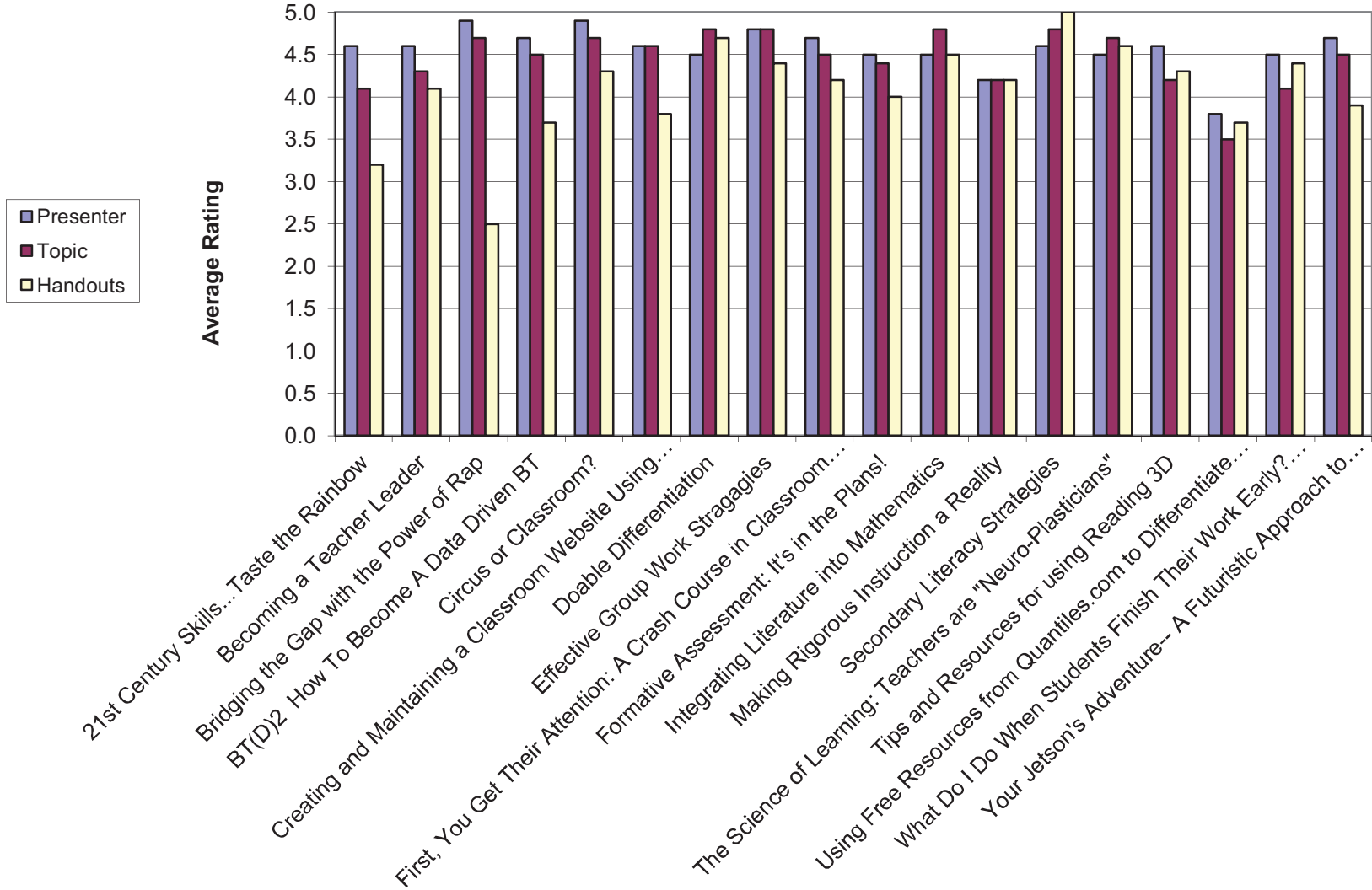
Concurrent Sessions Evaluation Summary - Overall - 2013
