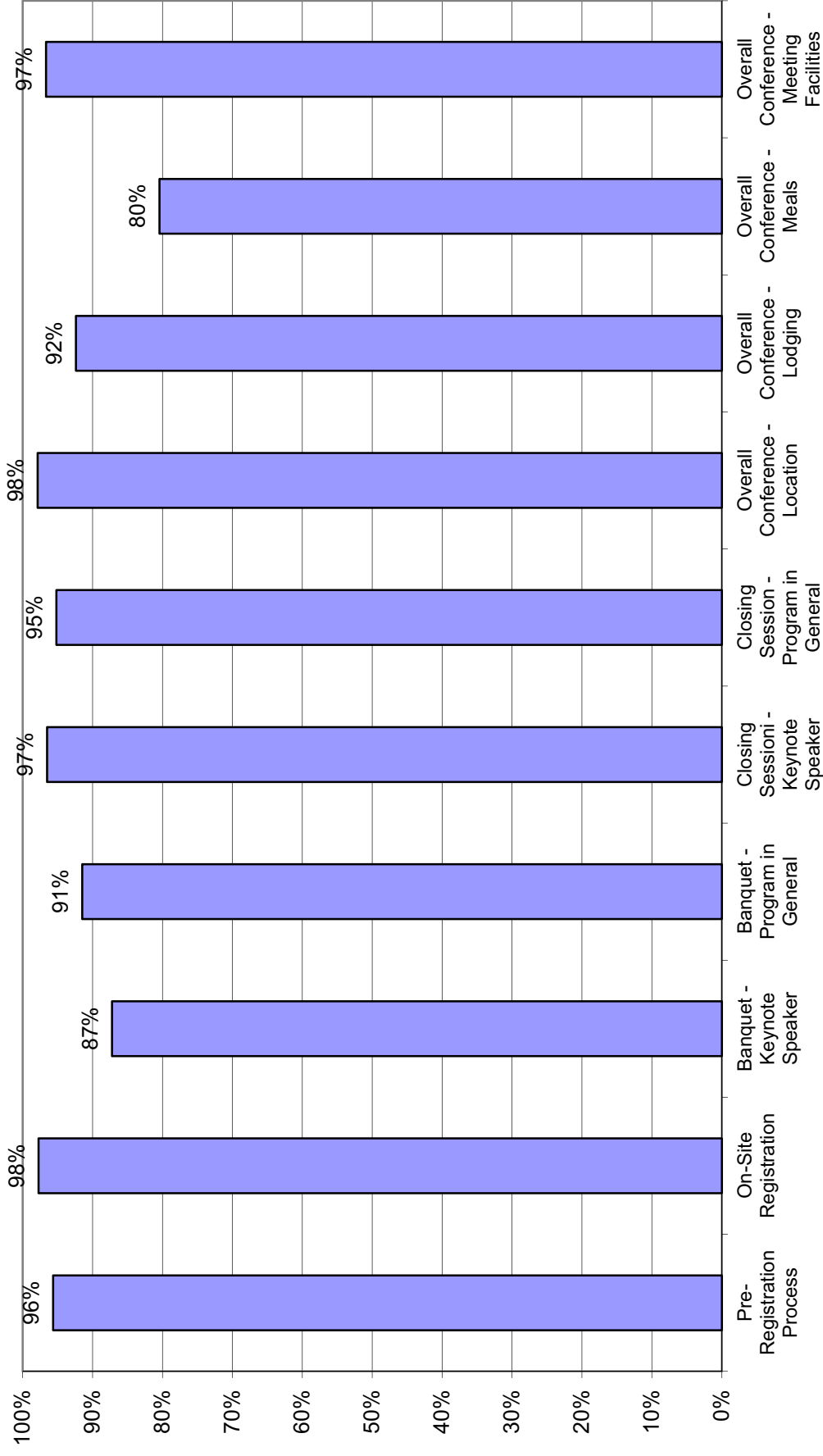

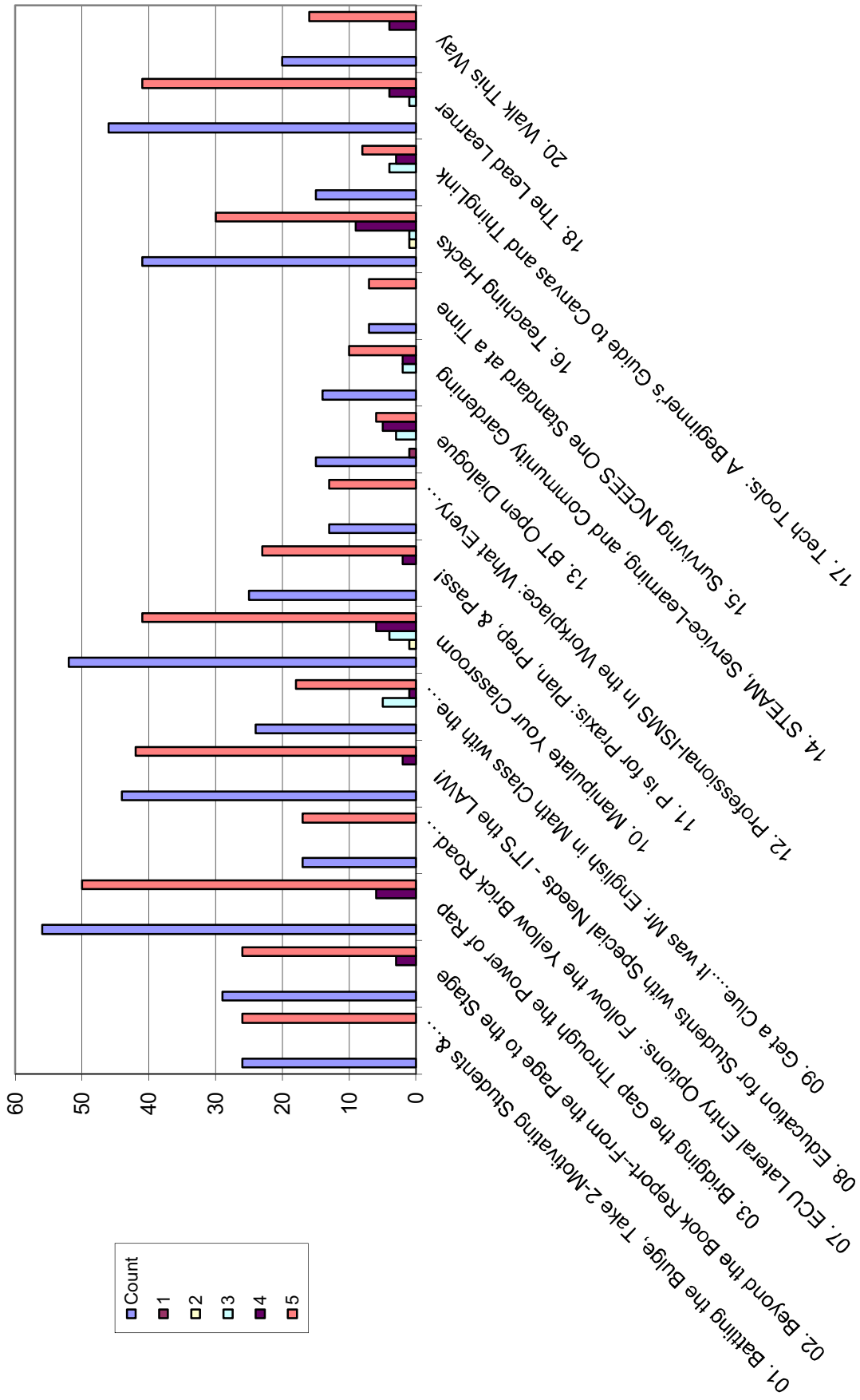

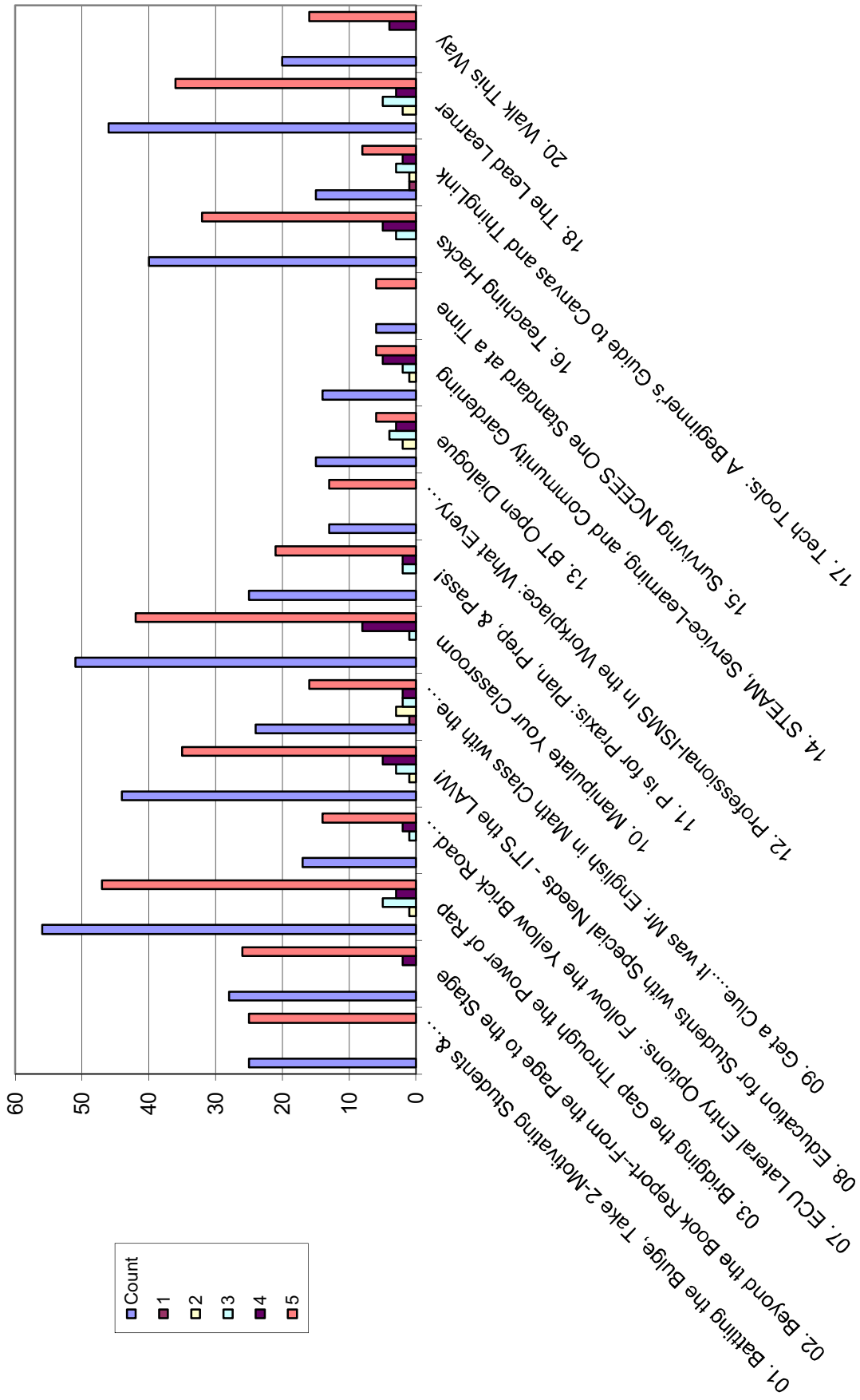

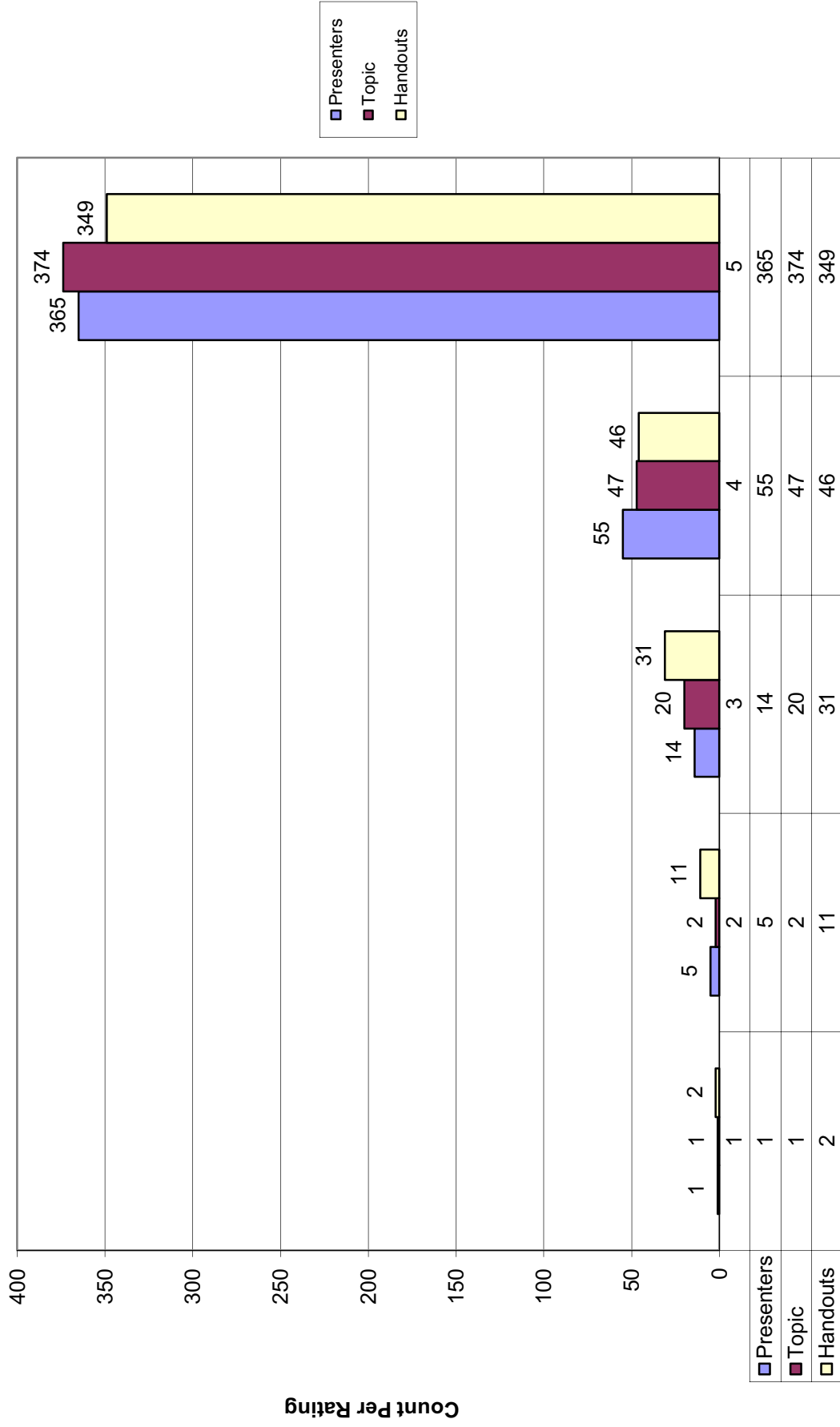
Concurrent Sessions Evaluation Summary - Topics - 2017



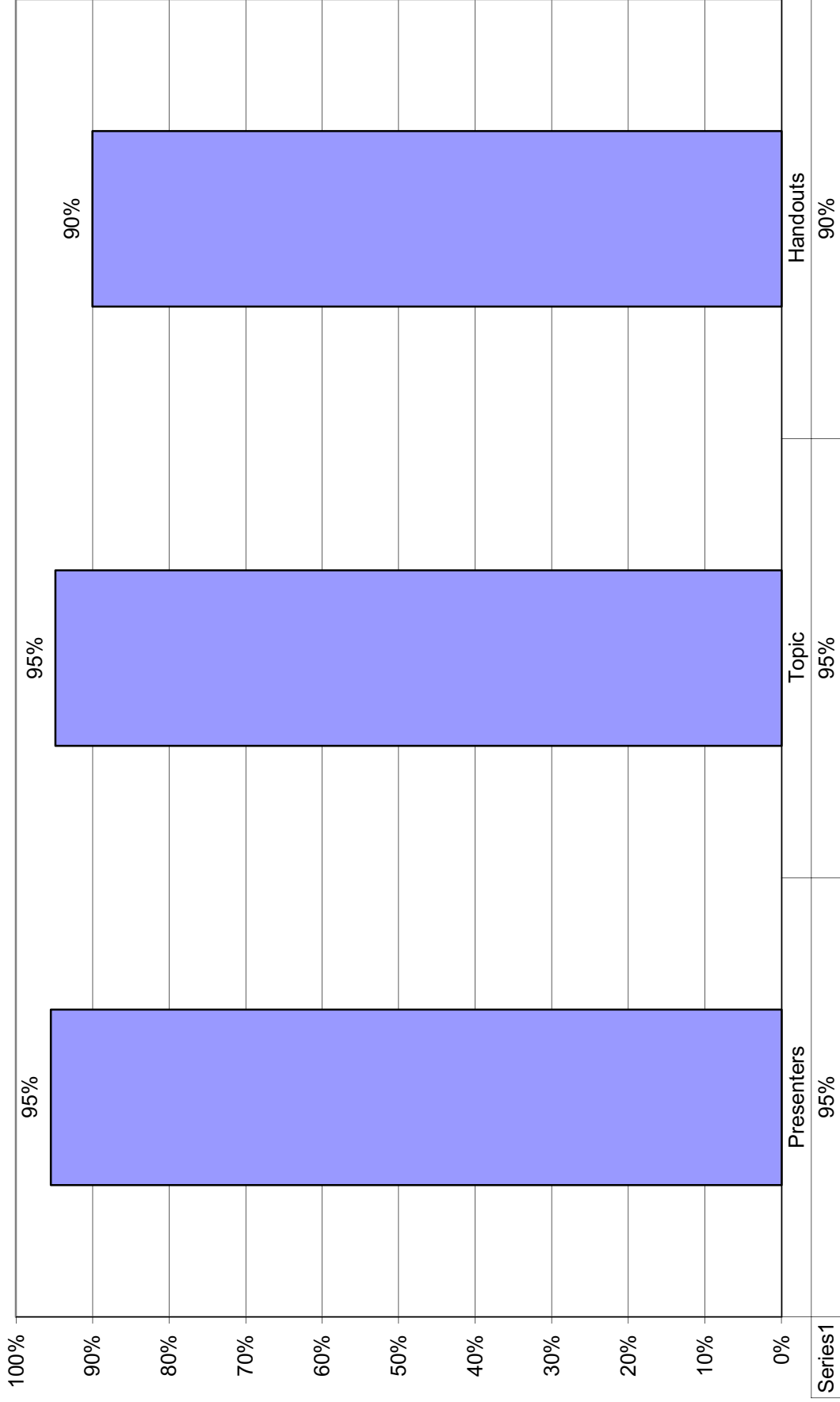
